A NEW TRADITION | THE HIGHLANDS CUP by Mark Williams

The Highlands Cup, a Ryder Cup style format, was played November 6th and 7th at the Highlands Course at Lake Arrowhead. The Highlands Cup consisted of two 12 man teams competing against each other in match play. The Blue Team, captained by Ward Brimmer, beat the Red Team, captained by David Olsen, 161/2 points to 131/2 points.

The Highlands Cup players competed in three 9-hole matches on Friday, a two man Four-Ball Match, a Foursomes Match (alternate Shot) and a Scrambles Match. Saturday's round consisted of 12 singles matches. A match was worth one point for a win, 1/2 point for a tie and zero points for a loss.

The Blue Team jumped out to a 3 1/2 point to 2 1/2 point lead after the morning Four-Ball Matches but the Red Team stormed back with a strong showing in the Foursomes Match to take the lead 6 1/2 to 5 1/2 heading into the late afternoon Scrambles Match. The Red Team continued its strong play winning 5 out of 6 six Scramble Matches to take a commanding 11 1/2 point to 6 1/2 point lead. The teams of Reidinger/Quigley, Olsen/Warnke, Hood/Rogers, Sommer/Conradsen and Thomas/Kreft were winners in their Scramble Matches for the Red Team.

On Saturday, the Blue Team down by 5 points, fought back early getting wins from Brimmer, Wert, Salese, Pyles and Strack to even the score 11 1/2 points to 11 1/2 points. With five matches reaming, the Blue Team continue to chalk up wins by Heppel, Reynolds, Johnson, Srok and Boone to put the Highlands Cup away by winning 10 of a possible 12 singles matches. The Red Team did get two singles match wins from Sommer and Reidinger but the out come had already been decided.

A banquet was held Saturday night to not only recognize the winning team but to thank all players for choosing to play in the inaugural Highlands Cup. A Highlands Cup plaque, with the Blue Team's players names engraved, will be placed in the Pro Shop to start a new tradition: The Highlands Cup.

ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATION UPDATE

Outdoor construction projects in Lake Arrowhead may require approval from county or state or federal regulators depending on the location and the amount of land disturbance. All work must be approved by Lake Arrowhead in addition to any governmental requirements. The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has authority to approve or disapprove all work from the high water mark back 25' on land and within 25' of any trout stream.

The EPD recently wrote a document to clarify minor land-disturbing activities as defined in the Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act, O.C.G.A. 12-7-17(3). Before planning any project for submittal to the Lake Arrowhead ARC for review, please consider the following information.

Land-disturbing activities that DO need approval from governmental authority include:

- Construction of a barbeque pit within the buffer.
- Construction of a new seawall, with land-disturbing activities.
- Construction of a decorative retaining wall within the buffer.
- Any land-disturbing activity utilizing wheeled or tracked machinery and equipment and equipment resulting in soil erosion within state waters.
- Paving with poured or prefab concrete.
- Any project or combination of projects on the same property resulting in more than 100 square feet of any elevated structures and/or pervious ground level walkways within the buffer.

After final stabilization of a site a buffer may be thinned of vegetation as long as a protective vegetative cover remains in sufficient quantity to keep shade on the stream bed.
