To Receive 2009 Boat Decals Property Owners must:

2. Sign the Boat Registration Form (REQUIRED with NO EXCEPTIONS)
3. Provide a copy of Proof of Insurance
4. Send Payment required for 2009 Boat Registration Fee
5. Have account in good standing

The Decals will be available only at the South Gate (located off Hwy 108) and the Membership Office .

NORTH GATE WILL NOT ISSUE BOAT DECALS FOR 2009

Upon successfully registering, the Club issued identification shall be permanently affixed to the front left side of the watercraft and to a visible location on or near the tongue of the trailer. False registration of non-Property Owner boats as Property Owner boats may result in fines and/or suspension of lake privileges.

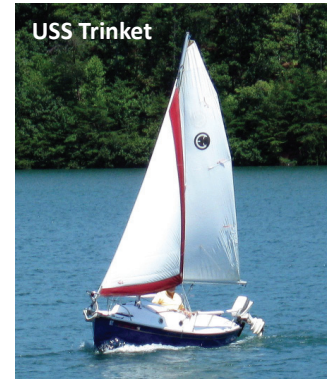

American Sailing Association Basic Keelboat Course (BKB 101)

During this time of year, sailing is still a lot of fun because of the good winds. The summer winds can be light and variable and this can be frustrating. Winter winds are strong and steady. This is the time to practice your skills on a keeled sailing sloop to prepare for some coastal or island sailing where the winds are usually 10-20 mph. To do so, we have a good boat right here on Lake Arrowhead (we have bigger boats on Lake Lanier - up to 36 feet). It is a Compac 16 and comes complete with roller furling, mainsail down haul, and boom traveler. It has a head (toilet) and cockpit cushions. This is a keeled sailboat sloop that weights about 2000 lbs with a displacement hull. Our instructors are available at \$25 an hour plus the cost of the boat rental. This is a very cost effective way of becoming an ASA certified sailor. This makes renting and chartering boats anywhere in the world much easier.



American Sailing Association Certified Coastal Navigation Classes (CON 105)

This is one of the ASA series of courses. There is no pre-requisite for this course. This course is taught in two sessions, over two days. To fit your schedule better, we have two classes scheduled. Also, you can come to the Session A (Theory) in one class than Session B (Application) in the other. This course is taught shore side in our classroom. It allows the student to predict the forces of tides and currents on their boat prior to sailing away. This is a "must have" course for anyone planning on sailing or cruising where tides or currents exist. It is also the prerequisite course for our ASA Advanced Coastal Cruising course. The course fees are \$149 per session. The first four students who sign up for both sessions get the ASA certification test free. A \$99 value.
