PADDLING TRIP

TRIP LEADER/ORGANIZER: *John Poidevant*

Take me to the river... Drop me in the water... These well known lyrics from the classic rock band, "The Talking Heads," ring true for paddlers this time of year. As a new property owner in Lake Arrowhead, I feel very fortunate to live in close proximity to many fine rivers. So, I would like to "float" an idea for a Lake Arrowhead Paddlers Group and see who might be interested in a river trip this summer. As a new member of the Lake Arrowhead Boating Club, I enjoy seeing the variety of watercraft on our lake including canoes, paddleboats, whitewater kayaks, graceful sea kayaks as well as the sailboats and powerboats. If you own a paddle craft or have access to one, please consider joining us for a river adventure. Here are the specifics:

WHAT Paddling trip on the Chestatee River in Dahlonega. You may want to consider a trip to the nearby Shane's Barbecue at the conclusion of the trip. It's going to get messy...

WHEN Saturday, July 23rd. Depart: 10:00am from the Lake Arrowhead Marina . Return: 4pm-6pm

WHO Members of the Lake Arrowhead Community. This is a mild river and suitable for children age 7 or older.

WHAT TO BRING Boat, paddles, life jackets, hats, river shoes, lunch, cooler, sun screen, towels, and change of clothes.

This is a free event with PAYOR (Paddle at your own risk) status.*

This section of the Chestatee is about 6 miles long and will take approximately 3 hours to complete. The river has a gentle flow, nice scenery, and the rapids do not exceed class 1. If the water level is too low at this time of year I will explore other nearby options such as the Etowah. SKIING REMINDERS

- It is illegal for the operator of the towing vessel or person(s) being towed to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- A boat or PWC must not tow persons on water skis or similar devices within 100 feet of a vessel not underway or adrift, a dock or pier, a bridge, a person in the water, a shoreline adjacent to a residence, a public park or beach, a swimming area, a marina, a restaurant, or any other public use area.

PROTECT THE ENVIRONMENT OF THE LAKE

- When operating your personal watercraft, consider the effect you may have on the environment.
- Make sure that the water you operate in is at least 30 inches deep. Riding in shallow water can cause bottom sediments or aquatic vegetation to be sucked into the pump, damaging your PWC and the environment.
- Avoid causing erosion by operating at slow speed and by not creating a wake when operating near shore or in narrow streams or rivers.

Well, it looks like Summer has arrived! If there is one thing in Georgia that seems to be in demand in the Summer it's water. Here are a few tips on how to manage your yard/landscape while saving some water.

An important aspect of your home yard is how much water to use. It's not necessary to water for hours every night; you just need to replace the amount of water lost to the environment that day. This is called the Evapotranspiration Rate or ET Rate for short. On the golf course, we use this as our measuring stick. For example, we know that if our sprinkler heads run for 4 minutes then that will put out 0.1" of water. So if we have a 0.2" ET then we would need to water each station for 8 minutes. We also have to keep in mind that it is easier to add water to the soil than it is to take it away. If you keep the soil too wet then that is how you get diseases in your grass and it becomes harder to manage. It is better to keep it on the dry side since it will rain...eventually!

There are some alternative ways to keeping your soil moist without using as much water. On your grass if you apply a wetting agent (such as Aqua-Aid) and water it in then you will probably only need to water your lawn every third night. If you re-apply this every 3-4 weeks you can get through the summer only using a third of the water you would normally use. If you are putting in some new plants and landscaping then it would be best if you used soil moist pellets. If you put the pellets in the soil before you plant your plant you won't need to water them every night.

These are just a few tips to help get through a tough time of the year!
