### GOLF INSTRUCTION: IMPACT POSITION

How can you improve your ball striking this golf season? One way is to work on your impact position. Many golfers spend a lot of time on their grip, posture, backswing or follow through but do not work on the "moment of truth" which is the correct impact position. I am not saying the other parts of the swing are not important but to play golf well you must be in a good impact position.

On the PGA or LPGA golf tours all the professionals have one thing in common and that is a good impact position. So, what is a good impact position? In Homer Kelley's book, "The Golf Machine", there are three imperatives to a good impact position. First, you must have a flat left wrist (right handed golfer), second you must sustain your clubhead lag pressure point (right hand index finger) and third you must have a straight plane line.

Let's take the first imperative—the flat left wrist. At impact the left wrist should be flat facing the target. The club shaft should be leaning forward and the grip end of the club should be leading the clubhead through impact. The left wrist should NEVER be cupped at impact. If your left wrist is cupped at impact it can lead to fat shots, thin shots and a loss of power. The second imperative is to sustain the clubhead lag pressure point. What this means is that you use the base of your right hand index finger to push against the shaft of the club. This pressure point should sustain the lag pressure against the shaft in a downward and forward motion through impact. In other words, the right wrist is still bent backwards at impact. If the pressure is not sustained then the clubhead could pass your hands before impact resulting in an inconsistent shot pattern with little power. The third imperative is the straight plane line which can be defined as the club shaft being in a straight line aligned with the right forearm through impact. If the club shaft is not properly aligned then you will lose directional control and will have to make compensations in your swing to hit the ball toward your target.

To hit the ball solidly, your wrists should NOT unhinge fully until after impact. A drill you can use to get a feel for the correct impact position is to hit punch shots with a 7-iron. Hit several punch shots with an abbreviated finish, keeping your hands leading the club well past impact with the club shaft still pointing at the ground after contact with the ball. Your divots should start in front of the ball. Once you start making solid contact then make your normal swing but try to feel the "punch shot" action through impact. If you start hitting the ball poorly again then you are flipping or casting the club through impact. Go back to hitting punch shots until you start making solid contact again.

Now you can see why PGA Tour player Jim Furyk, who has a double overlapping grip with a pronounced loop in his swing, is a world class player. At impact his left wrist is flat, his right wrist is still bent and his club is in a straight line position.

Lake Arrowhead is a wonderful place to get out, enjoy the fresh air, and catch some fish in the freshest water around! We have the ability to do fishing clinics and have special dawn and dusk reservation options. Currently we have two boat options that meet any fisherman's desires:

**Option 1:** For our fishing enthusiasts we have a pontoon boat. The pontoon boat holds 4 fishing people and it has a separate trolling motor, a fish-finder, live well, and a place to secure your pole when you need to take a break. It's eco-friendly and starts at \$65/hr. Or, the boat rents by the seat for \$35/person/seat for two hours. Fishing Guides are \$25/hour plus bait.



**Option 2:** Our small fishing boat with an electric trolling motor starts at just \$25/hr. It has room for 2 people (or 400 lbs) a place to lay your rods, tackle box and drink holders. It's the perfect size for a couple of hours out on the lake when the fish are really biting in the coves and far sided shore.

## PROPERTY OWNER UPDATES

### HUNTING IN LAKE ARROWHEAD

Lake Arrowhead does not allow any hunting on property. In addition to our own regulations, the State of Georgia prohibits firing or discharge of a firearm on property of another person, O.C.G.A. 16-11-104. Any person who violates this law is guilty of a misdemeanor. Contact the appropriate law enforcement agency to report hunting within the community. Listed below is information from the DNR website about poaching.

### PROPANE TANK FENCING

Propane tanks in Lake Arrowhead must be fenced or buried underground. In Phase II tanks must be buried, without exception. New fence design guidelines are available to help property owners construct fencing around the propane tank. You may download the design guidelines at [www.lakearrowheadclub.net](http://www.lakearrowheadclub.net). Please note this new fencing standard is the only approved fence for propane tanks constructed as of March 1, 2010. Existing fencing that is not in violation of the covenants for maintenance or repair is not subject to new guidelines. If you would like to inspect an example of a properly constructed enclosure, stop by the North Security Gate to view our recently installed propane screen.

### VEHICLE REGISTRATION

2010 Auto Decals are now being issued at both the North Gate and the South Gate. Be prepared with your photo ID and proof of registration. Resident Guests (Annual Renters) will need to update to a current 2010 Photo ID before new auto decals will be issued. Please have your new auto decals picked up before March 31. All accounts must be in good standing.

### BOAT DECALS

Boat decals can be picked up from the Main Office, located upstairs from the Pro Shop or at the South Gate. Boat Registration Form must be completed and proof of insurance provided before decals will be issued. All accounts must be in good standing.
